

RESOLUTION

**OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE
OHIO-KENTUCKY-INDIANA REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS**

**CONCERNING THE ADOPTION OF THE
WESTERN HAMILTON COUNTY TRANSPORTATION STUDY STRATEGIC PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Western Hamilton County Transportation Study Strategic Plan has been prepared by the Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments in consultation with the study Oversight Team (OT) which included the following agencies: the City of Cincinnati, the City of Harrison, Colerain Township, Congressman Chabot's Office, Crosby Township, Green Township, Hamilton County Engineer's Office, Senator Voinovich's Office, the Southwest Ohio Regional Transit Authority (SORTA), the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) and Whitewater Township; and

WHEREAS, the Western Hamilton County Transportation Study Strategic Plan has been prepared under the direction of an Advisory Committee representing diverse perspectives in the public and private sectors and through an extensive public participation effort; and

WHEREAS, the Western Hamilton County Transportation Study Strategic Plan accounts for other planning initiatives at the corridor, regional and state levels; and

WHEREAS, the Western Hamilton County Transportation Study Strategic Plan has identified transportation improvements for the study area; and

RESOLVED, that the Executive Committee of the Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments at its public meeting of February 8, 2007 adopts the Western Hamilton County Transportation Study Strategic Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the high priority transportation recommendations as identified by the Western Hamilton County Transportation Study Strategic Plan as "Regional Corridor Project Priorities" will be considered for inclusion in the *OKI 2030 Regional Transportation Plan* subject to air quality and fiscal constraint requirements.
