- (1) Please find attached the minutes from our first Advisory Team meeting held on October 9<sup>th</sup>. If you have any edits, please let me know. Thank you again to everyone for the great discussion, direction and support that was shared. The group's input is a tremendous help to staff as we work to finalize of the Plan's Needs Assessment.
- (2) As a result of the October 9<sup>th</sup> meeting and in support of engaging more stakeholders from southern portion of the county, the Kenton County Transportation Plan will be the main agenda topic at the next meeting of the South Kenton County Group which is scheduled for November 21, 2013 at the Piner Firehouse from 6:30-8:30pm. NKAPC and OKI staff will both be in attendance to present information on the Plan and gather input from the group.
- (3) In October, OKI staff led a very-focused social media campaign to reach community members from throughout the county and increase online survey responses. NKAPC staff and members from several community organizations greatly assisted in making this effort a success! Special thanks to Sharmili Reddy and James Fausz for their efforts. We are happy to report now that the Halloween deadline for the survey is over that a total of 432 responses were received! Staff will be reviewing each and every response and incorporating input into the Needs Assessment. Broken-down by transportation mode, the survey comments were:
  - Driving (Roadways) = 225
  - Bicycling = 93
  - Walking (Pedestrian-related concerns) = 61
  - Transit = 40
  - Freight = 13
