Mason-SR741 Cox-Smith to Spyglass	Remove the existing bottleneck between Cox-Smith Rd and Spy Glass Hill. The typical section includes two lanes of travel in each direction, traffic calming medians with left turn lanes at all intersections.	\$3,275,938	\$2,183,959
