CBT Material Handler Purchase RFP – Q&A

1. Q: What is the maximum material weight you will be handling? (per cubic yd or cubic ft)
A. 280 cubic feet.

2. Q: Why is a 5 cu yd bucket requested?
A. CBT handles a variety of product sizes. A five (5) cubic yard bucket is the largest that the company has used to date. Therefore, a five (5) cubic yard bucket is viewed as a maximum limitation rather than a minimum.

3. Q: What hourly, and or daily tonnage do you need to move to be productive?
A. Hourly production is targeted at 500 tons per hour.

4. Q: What is the delivery date you require?
A. CBT is not requiring any specific delivery deadline, however, please note that delivery date is a critical factor in the decision. Please provide your most realistic delivery date. CBT will make a final selection by July 20, 2021, and initiate the equipment purchase process immediately.

5. Q: Could a two stage boom be considered?
A. Yes, a two-stage boom may be considered if the proposed, new equipment meets the RFP's stated reach and tons per hour specifications. However, a three-stage boom is preferred.
