Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

- Short Range component of the OKI 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)
- Last new OKI TIP was April 2023
- TIP is fiscally-constrained
- Funding Commitments for next 4 years: projects listed with funding amounts, funding source, phase, and fiscal year.
- Any project with federal funds and any regionally-significant project must be listed
- TIP becomes part of Statewide TIP (STIP)

FY26-29 TIP Adoption Schedule

- 3/10/25 – Start of Public Involvement Period
- 3/13/25 – presentation of Draft TIP to OKI Executive Committee
- 4/1/25 – Public meeting
- 4/10/25 – OKI Board of Directors approves TIP/End of Public Involvement
- 4/18/25 - Final TIP and Conformity documentation to ODOT, KYTC, INDOT
- 5/1/25-6/30/25 – USDOT Review and Approval
- 7/1/25 – Effective date of approved TIP

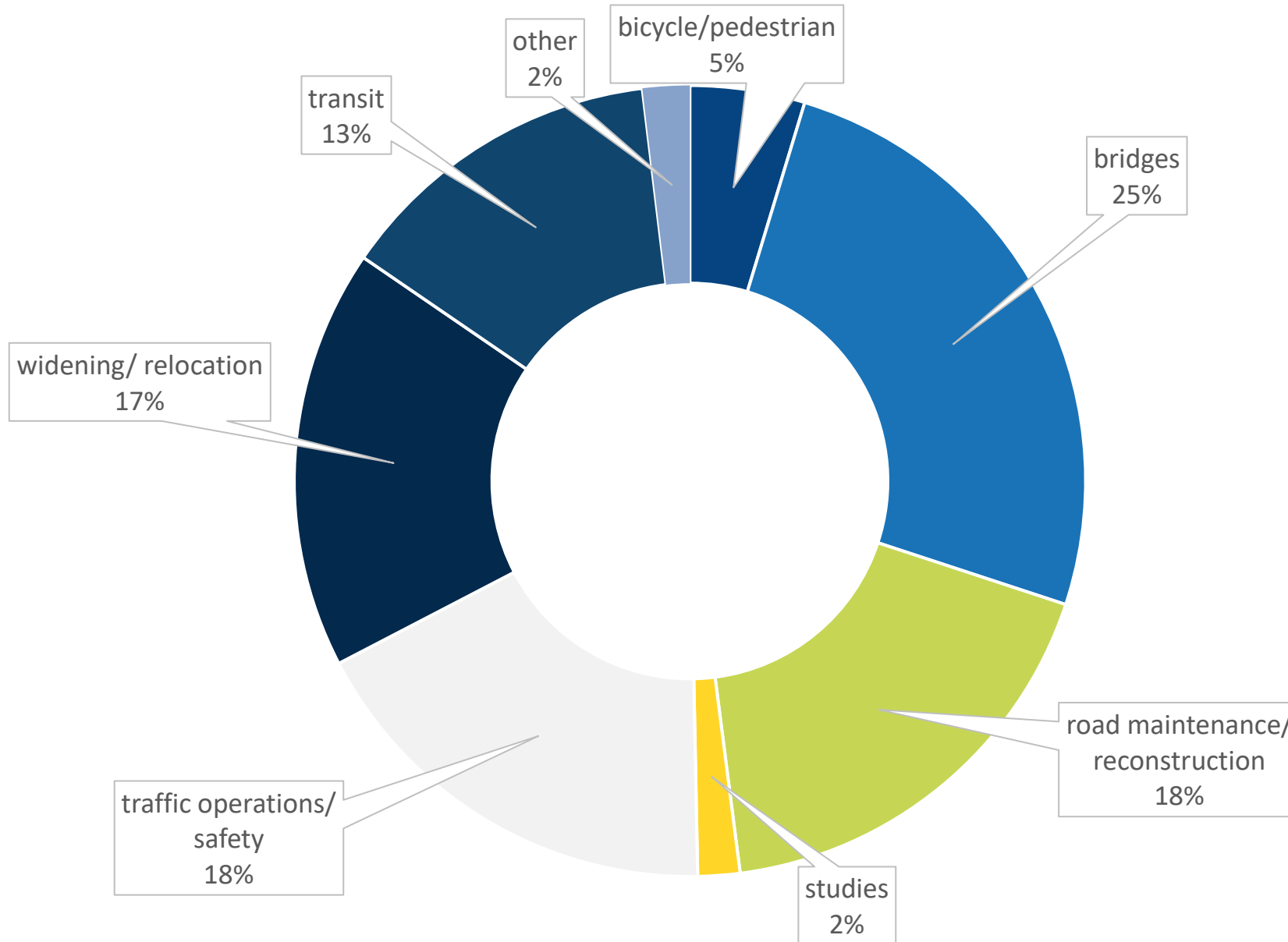
Programmed Funds – FY26-29 TIP

- \$4.8B federal, state and local
- \$2.0B Federal Funds,
 - \$239 M in OKI Sub-Allocated Federal Funds

New Projects in OKI FY26-29 TIP

- 7 Projects with previously awarded OKI funds
 - 4 STBG in Ohio
 - 3 TA in Ohio
- ODOT, KYTC, INDOT “Grouped Projects”
 - Routine road/bridge maintenance, slide repair
- 3 KY Projects moving from MTP to TIP
- 43 Transit Projects (i.e. operating, preventative maintenance, vehicles, equipment)
