ANNUAL LISTING OF OBLIGATED PROJECTS
OHIO AND INDIANA**



September 15, 2026

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The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) was signed into law on November 15, 2021. The Act is the largest long-term investment in our infrastructure and economy in our Nation's history. It provides \$550 billion over fiscal years 2022 through 2026 in new Federal investment in infrastructure, including roads, bridges, and mass transit, water infrastructure, resilience, and broadband. The Act continues the requirement that Metropolitan Planning Organizations prepare an annual listing of projects, including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities, for which Federal funds have been obligated in the preceding year under 23 U.S.C or 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53. The listing shall be published no later than 90 calendar days following the end of the program year and made available by the cooperative effort of the state, transit operator and metropolitan planning organization for public review. The following tables and maps provide information on transportation projects located in the Ohio and Indiana portions of the OKI region that were obligated for spending using federal funds during state fiscal year 2026--July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026. Kentucky projects will be listed in a separate report covering federal fiscal year 2026--October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026 by December 31, 2026.

The OKI region includes Butler, Clermont, Hamilton and Warren counties in Ohio; Boone, Campbell and Kenton counties in Kentucky; and Dearborn County in Indiana. This report lists highway and transit projects that have funds obligated in fiscal year 2026. Some of these projects may have been awarded in previous fiscal years and had federal funds authorized prior to fiscal year 2026. The information provided is consistent with how projects are listed in the OKI TIP, i.e. projects are shown with a project identification number, facility name, location, description of project, project type and funding amounts. This list provides information on the amount of funds programmed in the TIP, the amount of federal funds that were authorized during fiscal year 2026 and the amount of funds remaining and available for use in subsequent years. Projects are listed by state and then numerically by the project identification number (PID) in Ohio, or DES number in Indiana. The primary project type is listed, however, projects often have components of other types. For example, a roadway maintenance projects may contain elements that improve bicycle or pedestrian travel.

Project obligation information is also provided for five federally funded transit operators in the Ohio portion of the region: Butler County Regional Transit Authority (BCRTA), Clermont Transportation Connection (CTC), City of Cincinnati Streetcar, the Southwest Ohio Regional Transit Authority (SORTA) and the Warren County Transit (WCTS).

An obligation is the federal government's legal commitment to pay the federal share of a project's cost. An obligated project is one that has been authorized by a federal agency, such as the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) or the Federal Transit Administration (FTA). Obligated projects are not necessarily initiated or completed in the programmed year and the amount of the obligation may not necessarily equal the total cost of the project. For FTA projects, obligation occurs when the FTA grant is awarded. For FHWA projects, the obligation occurs when a project agreement is executed and the state/grantee requests that the funds be obligated.
